

Shabbat T'fillah Train



Many students need visual organizers to help them understand concepts. Create a "T'fillah Train" out of boxes to help your students and to keep you organized.

IDEAS FOR THE T'FILLAH TRAIN...

- Put the Hebrew on one side of the box and the English on the other side. This way it will make sense from both directions.
- You can make flashcards from vocabulary so that students can sort them into the boxes.
- Put copies of the individual prayers on laminated cards. Have the students sort the prayers into the appropriate sections of the service.
- The t'fillah train is a great way to show that some form of the kaddish is used to separate each section of the service. There are 5 forms of the kaddish. Some are used as minor breaks in the liturgy and some serve as major breaks. (Kaddish deRabbanan comes after the warm up and before the main event, hatzi kaddish comes prior to and after the Torah service etc.....)
